God also gave me better health so that I could wear high-heeled shoes. Until then I used to wear comfortable and low loafers because I felt tired with high-heeled shoes.

Many members of my district received blessing and answer after they listened to the 4-session message “The Seed of Life”: a new believer Brother Sangdon Lee was healed of 10-year dermatitis on the head and quit smoking and drinking; Deaconess Sooki Kim received blessing at her business; Deacon Hyungryul Han could exercise self-control and lost his weight by 6 kg; Senior Deaconess Guiyeon Choi was healed of allergic dermatitis; and Deacon Taesoon Lee was healed of the pain on the back of his head.

1. We should get involved only in spiritual thoughts.

In whatever kind of difficulties, we should look at it with spiritual eyes and take actions with spiritual thoughts and heart. A maxim goes, "Everything depends on our mind." In the same situation, the prosperity of our affair depends on the choice of our mind. It is really true in faith, too. If we keep on setting our mind on spiritual thoughts, they are revealed into actions of the spirit, and we bear the fruits of the spirit and receive blessings. On the contrary, if we follow fleshly thoughts, we show fleshly actions and bear the fruits of the flesh.

people of the world have to overcome difficulties with their own strength and willpower if they want to think and act positively. God's children can be empowered with the strength of God, become filled with the hope for Heaven in faith, and even more conditions of thanksgiving than the people in the world. If we think of spiritual things and rely on God, His grace and blessing can come upon us.

2. We have to keep our heart and arm ourselves with the truth lest worldly things should break in.

Spiritual thoughts are operated in the truth. They lead us to think of everything with faith, hope and love, and cause us to give thanks and rejoice all the time and look at everything with goodness. Conversely, fleshly thoughts cause us to get involved in all kinds of untruths including hatred, ill-feelings, complaints, and grumbling. Doubting thoughts and negative thoughts also belong to fleshly thoughts.

If we always follow spiritual thoughts, we can keep our heart and abide in the truth so that we can have confidence before God. Instead, if we allow the worldly things to break in and we take them, spiritual confidence will immediately disappear. It is because we feel sorry and restless even if we may not be disciplined immediately. In order to cut off worldly things, we should neither look at nor listen to nor seek worldly things.

Romans 8:6 reads, "For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the Spirit is life and peace." With this Scripture, we have to examine what kind of thoughts cause us to be filled with the Holy Spirit and have comfort or cause us to feel distressed and burdened. If we continually involve ourselves in negative thoughts, is it possible that the current situation changes or we receive the strength to bear good fruits? Instead, we may have discomforts in heart and lose strength and enthusiasm. The things finally worsen.

If anyone carelessly takes even the smallest things belonging to the world which is full of sins and evils, he may become imbued with fleshly things easily and quickly. Fleshly things worldly people enjoy begin to seem attractive to him, and he takes it little by little saying, "Is it wrong for me to take the things all others do?" Those things may not lead him to death immediately, but as he takes those fleshly things, he comes to desire more of them. In the end, he cannot exercise self-control about them. Even though he tries to cut them off saying, "I must not do them," he cannot listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit and becomes

submerged in severer fleshly things. That's why we should never accept even a small thing from the beginning, if it is any temptation of the world.

God wants His beloved children to become sanctified. He wants them to fill their heart with the love for God, the hope for Heaven, the desire to glorify God by bearing fruits in their God-given duties, and longing heart for sanctification. If you find something that triggers you to seek worldly things, you have to acknowledge it is a work of Satan and then boldly drive it away in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. In a word, if you cut off the world and the worldly things and keep your heart with the truth, it is a shortcut to lead an exemplary life and fulfill your heart's desires.

3. We should cultivate faithfulness in everything to bear fruits.

The duty of men is to have a reverent fear of God. He who really fears God is not only faithful in his duties assigned by the church but also faithfully bears fruits in all aspects. Of course, he puts his God-given duties ahead of all other duties, but at the same time he performs the duties as a child, a parent, and a member of societies he belongs to. If you worship God in truth and spirit and pray to God with faith and love, you are surely guided to be faithful in all aspects by supervision of the Holy Spirit. And when you faithfully perform the duty of men and bear fruits, you can glorify God and become joy to the church.

For this, you have to spend each day and each hour in detailed plans and do everything with all your heart and sincerity. Above all, you have to attend the worship service and prayer meetings with a longing heart for the grace of God and godly heart. In addition, you have to be faithful in everything with clear purpose of glorification of God.

If you do your best to look at and listen to everything with the standard of truth and think of everything with the truth, God will give you wisdom, understanding, strength and good health, and fulfill your heart's desires.

Therefore, may you abide in the love of God and resemble the Lord more and more so that you can bear abundant fruits and glorify God, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ I pray!

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Estonia, a Beautiful Country in the Northern Europe

Estonia, which is a state in the Baltic Region of the Northern Europe in the world map, does not sound familiar to Koreans, but a very renowned land for travel mania. It is because it has many beautiful remains of the culture of Middle Age. Estonia is bordered to the north by the Gulf of Finland, to the west by the Baltic Sea, to the south by Latvia, and to the east by the Russian Federation.

It is influenced by a temperate seasonal climate, and the Estonians are a Finnic people, and the official Estonian language is closely related to Finnish.

Tallinn, Capital City of Estonia, Which Has Many Cultural Remains

Tallinn, the capital and largest city of Estonia, is situated on the northern coast of the country, on the banks of the Gulf of Finland, 80 km (50 mi) south of Helsinki, west of Saint Petersburg. Historically, the city of Tallinn has been attacked, sacked, razed and pillaged on numerous occasions. Although extensively bombed by Soviet air forces during the latter stages of World War II, much of the medieval Old Town still retains its beauty. So, the Tallinn Old Town was declared World Heritage Site by the UNESCO in 1997.

There is no doubt that Tallinn is the biggest centre for tourists in Estonia. The historic Old Town with its numerous sights is one of the most impressive medieval monuments in Europe. At the same time, the growing economic metropolis is the only traffic junction in the country and provides to its visitors numerous international and regional transport connections. Major sights include Raekoja plats (Town Hall square), the town walls and towers (notably 'Fat Margaret' and 'Kiek in de K ok') and St Olaf church tower (124 m).

Estonia regained its independence on August 20, 1991. It has since embarked on a rapid program of social and economic reform. Today, the country has gained recognition for its economic freedom, its adaptation of new technologies and was one of the world's fastest growing economies for several years. However, Estonia's economy was the second worst hit of all 27 European Union members in the 2007-2010 economic crisis, contracting sharply in the first quarter of 2009. In March 2007, Estonia allowed Internet voting for Parliamentary elections, becoming the first country to do so. Prime Minister Andrus Ansip's Reform Party narrowly won the election, taking 31 out of 101 seats, just two more than the Centre Party.



Estonians Persistently Preserved Their Identity Despite Incessant Invasions of Foreign Powers

Throughout much of its history, Estonia surrounded with the shores of the Baltic Sea and the Gulf of Finland has been subjugated by foreign occupying powers. However, Estonians stubbornly preserved their identity through foreign dominations and finally were victorious in their War for Independence in 1918-1920, fighting both Soviet Russia and the German Landeswehr colonizers. In 1920, the Russians agreed and signed on the treaty of Tartu, and recognized Estonia as an independent country. During its independence 1918-1940, Estonia was a model society in the community of nations, a member of the League of Nations. Estonia guaranteed cultural

policies of glasnost (openness) and perestroika (reconstruction). Once again the Estonian began to clamour for independence. In November 1988 the Supreme Soviet (a kind of parliament) in Estonia declared that Soviet laws would only apply in Estonia if it agreed to them. Also in 1988 Estonia was given some economic autonomy. Estonia declared independence from the Soviet Union in March 1990. Soviet resistance ensued, but after recognition by European and other countries, the Soviet Union acknowledged Estonian nationhood on September 6, 1991. UN membership followed on September 17. In 2004, Estonia became a member of the European Union as well as of NATO.

Ethnic Groups and Religion of Estonia

Estonia is bordered to the north by the Gulf of Finland, to the west by the Baltic Sea, to the south by Latvia (343 km), and to the east by the Russian Federation (338.6 km). The territory of Estonia covers 45,227 km2 (17,462 sq mi) and the official Estonian language is closely related to Finnish. Estonia is a democratic parliamentary republic and is divided into fifteen counties. The capital and largest city is Tallinn. With a population of only 1.34 million, Estonia is one of the least-populous members of the European Union. Today's Estonia is a multinational country where, according to the 2000 census, altogether 109 languages are spoken. 67.3% of Estonian citizens speak Estonian as their mother tongue, 29.7% - Russian and 3% speak other languages. As of 2 July 2010, 84.1% of Estonian residents are Estonian citizens, 8.6% are citizens of other countries and 7.3% are 'citizens with undetermined citizenship.' Since 1992 roughly 140,000 people have acquired Estonian citizenship through naturalization. Estonia's constitution guarantees freedom of religion, separation of church and state, and individual rights to privacy of belief and religion. Estonia has one of the highest level of irreligious individuals in the world; nearly three-quarters of the population stating no specific religious affiliation in 2000. The largest religious faith in the country is Evangelical Lutheranism, adhered to by 14.8% of the population, principally ethnic Estonians. Just behind this group in size is the Eastern Orthodox, practiced chiefly by the Russian minority. According to the census of 2000, there were about 152,000 Lutherans, 143,000 Orthodox Christians, 5,000 Roman Catholics, and 1,000 adherents of Taaraism or Mausk in Estonia. In addition there were around 68,000 people who declared themselves to be atheists.
