

I used to be Hindu. My mother converted to Christianity after she had been healed of heart disease by prayer of a Christian. Her story of healing influenced all family members to convert to Christianity, but I accepted the Lord four years later.

In May of 2009, I visited OM Books Shop located in Guwahati, the state of Assam, India. I received much grace reading Manmin News in Hindi that had been placed in the shop. I made a phone call to Delhi Manmin Mission Center with the number written in the newspaper. Brother Raju there answered my questions and began to send me Manmin News regularly.

## "With the Power of God, It is Easy to Spread the Gospel!"

Watching the DVD that showed God's powerful works manifested through Dr. Lee's prayer, I was so amazed that I even felt like I had an electronic shock. I was filled with the Holy Spirit and came to be eager to spread the great power of God to others and to experience it firsthand.

In July 2009, I asked Delhi Manmin Mission Center to send me Dr. Lee's books. I read seven books including *The Message of the Cross*, *The Measure of Faith*, *Heaven I & II*, *Hell*, and *Awaken Israel*. After reading them, I could not help preaching the gospel.

In particular, I liked *The Message of the Cross* which suggests 'the way of salvation' and 'the providence of the cross' and *The Measure of Faith* which shows the readers a shortcut to resemble the

Lord. These contain amazing unheard of messages.

Spreading the holiness gospel and the power of God not only in India but in Nepal and Bhutan

I paid a visit to a cable broadcasting station which covers all areas in Shillong, Meghalaya, India on December 22, 2009. I gave them 'Power of God IV' DVD and made best efforts for it to be broadcast through the station even spending my own money.

Carrying a DVD player and a TV monitor in my car, I have presented 'Power of God IV' in churches and towns. Many people have been touched by the message of the cross of Jesus Christ. I also have introduced Muan Sweet Water which was changed from salty water of the sea to drinkable water through Dr. Lee's prayer. Whoever used it by faith received healings

and converted to Christianity.

I have a room to conduct Manmin's ministry in my house. I have Manmin News, Dr. Lee's books, and Muan Sweet Water in the room. If there is someone who wants them, I send them to the person.

Since December 23, 2009, I have sent 120 DVDs to churches in Nepal. I preached the gospel in my wife's hometown in Bhutan. I am learning the language of Khasis which is spoken by a tribe living in the mountainous areas in the Northeastern India, Bangladesh, and Assam in order to spread the gospel among them. Its population reaches upwards of around 1,360,000. Materials for evangelization of the areas were translated into their language. I will try my best for spreading the holiness gospel which I learned through MIS (Manmin International Seminary) programs.

About 100 families in Assam of India converted to Christianity

A 20-year-old woman Sunita Mirda living in a village of Tezpara in Assam of India had been possessed with an evil spirit for a year. She had to be kept in her room and taken care of by her family because she had caused many problems like throwing things. Many pastors had prayed for her, but there was no difference. At that time, her father came to know Manmin's ministry and wanted to receive Dr. Lee's prayer for her.

I informed Pastor John Kim (Delhi Manmin Mission Center) of their problem. Pastor Kim asked for Dr. Lee's prayer and received his prayer on their behalf during Friday all-night service. Surprisingly, she came to be set free from evil spirit and became normal.

After seeing this fascinating work of God, her family members and the villagers converted from Hinduism to Christianity. At first only 20 families converted, but the news was spread to neighbors and about 100 families converted to Christianity. This is because her father was influential in the village and her relatives lived closely.

## 2011 Jerusalem International Book Fair Featured with the Holiness Gospel through Dr. Jaerock Lee's Books *The Way of Salvation, Heaven I & II, Hell and Awaken Israel*

The 25<sup>th</sup> Jerusalem International Book Fair was held in International Convention Center in Jerusalem, Israel for 6 days starting from February 20, 2011. At this book fair, Dr. Jaerock Lee's books in multiple languages were exhibited and the love of Jesus Christ spread in Israel once again. It was in this International Convention Center in Jerusalem that Dr. Lee had boldly proclaimed two years ago that Jesus Christ is the Messiah and Savior. Many miraculous healings and powerful works that confirmed his message were manifested.

Representatives of Urim Books (www.urimbooks.com) that attended this book fair displayed Dr. Lee's various books including *The Message of the Cross*, *Heaven I & II*, *Hell*, and *My Life My Faith I & II*. These books have been translated into 23 languages including Hebrew, Arabic, Russian, and English. Also among the books was *Awaken, Israel*, which includes God's will towards Israel.

# The Hope of Heaven

“Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth.” (Colossians 3:2)

We will be rewarded with eternal dwelling places and blessings in Heaven to the same extent we live by the Word of God, resemble the Lord, and work faithfully for God's kingdom. That's why those who have faith do not seek vain things which will become corrupt and disappear, but set their minds on the things above and run with the hope for New Jerusalem. What kind of life do we have to lead if we have the hope for Heaven?

First of all, those who have the hope of Heaven do not live a life of falsehood.

Not everybody who seems to be leading an enthusiastic life in faith really has the hope for Heaven. There are people who cheat God, the Lord, and the Holy Spirit, and even themselves. Of course, nobody can cheat the Almighty God.

Here, to cheat means they don't change their hearts by the truth but they just pretend to be practicing the will of God in hypocrisy. In most cases, however, they not only nicely and effectively cover for themselves, but they also deceive and cheat themselves.

They don't circumcise their hearts. They make a pretense of living by the Word of God, having reverence for God, and having great faith and faithfulness. They have to check whether they shun worldly things because they really put their hope in Heaven, or because they want to earn the recognition of others.

This was the case with the Pharisees and the priests at the time of Jesus. They didn't circumcise their hearts because they did not understand God's true will. They just keep God's commandments outwardly to show themselves off. They even had deluded themselves into thinking that it was the deeds themselves that were seen as faith by God. However, God, who searches each one's heart, does not desire the outward deeds that are revealed before men; He wants the righteousness cultivated in our hearts.

If we really put our hope in Heaven and love God, we will produce true fruits. For example, if you really love God, you will love your brothers, too. You will constantly have consideration for others as you interact with other people. You will rejoice when others are doing well. Even when others' faults are revealed, you will try to cover for that person. You will try to have consideration for the viewpoints and hearts of others. In other words, if you really love God, you will bear the fruit of loving your brothers as you love yourself.

In addition, those who put their hope in Heaven come to worship and prayer services because they feel joy and happiness when they are in communion with God. They also change their hearts and bear the fruit of true righteousness through those times. They don't just work to the extent to be noticed by others or just do that which has been given to them, but they fulfill their duties completely.

Those who have the hope of Heaven, secondly, will improve themselves and consider their duty precious.

As you accomplish your duties over a long period of time, you become accustomed to it. But the problem is, when people become accustomed to their work, there are some people who begin to do it as a matter of habit without making any improvements. This may even continue for 10 to 20 years or more. Or, they just do the same work they have been doing for so many years.

You should not be at ease because you are confident about your work, but you have to have constant improvement receiving wisdom through prayer. Also, if you become accustomed to a certain work, you can expand and fulfill more duties to the extent your time and abilities allow. You have to dedicate yourself continually thinking about what you can do for the kingdom of God. You also have to improve your abilities and skills even to match the experts in the world. By doing so, you can extend God's kingdom and receive rewards in Heaven through your faithfulness.

Of course, it does not mean that the physical skills are so important that you neglect the spiritual development. Even though they received the best education and talents, those who commit sins have nothing to do with God. Those who do not pray and those who break peace cannot be used for God's kingdom. Those who have hope of Heaven not just live by the Word of God, but can receive the guidance of the Holy Spirit to improve their physical skills. You have to become more skillful workers as you try your best and receive wisdom and understanding from above.

Those who put their hope in Heaven, thirdly, should long for spiritual things.

How happy and joyful were you as you began to experience the spiritual realm when you came to church for the first time? You cried out in prayer in the sanctuary whenever you had time, and you listened to audio recordings of the sermons for

hours and hours. When you received a little duty in the church, you were thankful from the heart and made up your mind to fulfill your precious duty properly. You gathered in the church even after you finished work, and you knelt before God to pray as much as possible. And yet, you did not say it was hard or tiring, but you were happy that you could do works of God. This is because you longed for spiritual things and the hope of Heaven overflowed in your heart.

Additionally, in order to fulfill your duties you must long for spiritual things. What happens when you lose your first love and your zeal cools down? You just try to do as little work as possible, and you don't want to do more difficult work that requires more time and effort. You try to avoid responsibility or something that may be cumbersome in an effort to have as much personal time as possible. These show that you do not long for rewards in Heaven and spiritual things. Considering this fact, if you received God-given duties, how much more time and effort should you put in to fulfilling them?

If you really consider your duties precious and have spiritual eagerness, you must also understand the will of God and try to obey it. You must be taught what you have to do and what vision you should harbor. I pray in the name of the Lord that, in doing so, you will enjoy praises and honor in Heaven.

# Are You Being Careful with the Words that Pass through Your Lips?

## No Careless Word Allowed!

There are words that are allowed to be spoken and there are those that are not ever to be spoken. We have to speak the words that are appropriate for the situation and the listeners. It is recorded in Proverbs 10:19, "When there are many words, transgression is unavoidable, but he who restrains his lips is wise." Even good words that are spoken too much and spoken without restraint may not give grace to the listener. Also, words that may be spoken with good intention may be mistaken and be misunderstood by others.

Our Lord Jesus said in Matthew 15:18, "But the things that proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and those defile the man," and Matthew 12:35, "The good man brings out of his good treasure what is good; and the evil man brings out of his evil treasure what is evil." Accordingly, although you have not committed sins in action, when you are not cautious about your words, you are found to be slow in receiving answers and blessings from God.

As warned in the first half of Proverbs 13:2, "From the fruit of a man's mouth he enjoys good," you should examine your words always and set a guard over your mouth so that you can receive whatever you have asked of God.

Jesus teaches us saying in Matthew 12:36, "But I tell you that every careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment." It is true that we can be forgiven of any sin when we repent and turn back, but the problem is that many people forget the words that they have spoken out carelessly.

Lies are not only careless, but they are also harmful to both yourself and others. If the other person accepts your lies as the truth, he may suffer from losses in finance and faith. Lying itself is a sin in the sight of God. In any circumstances, you should not tell the slightest lie and not conceal the smallest thing, either.

You may give wrong answers for various reasons: because you are telling lies; because you are attributing the fault to others; or because you are making excuses. If you have a truthful heart and no attribute of falsehood at all, you won't give wrong answers to any question. Many people give wrong answers because they do not listen to the other person carefully, but get involved in their own thoughts instead. Therefore, you can avoid giving wrong answers only if you carefully listen to others.

Silly talk and coarse jestings are never appropriate for the children of God. And if you exaggerate the reality and say absurd words that do not stand to reason, it is not appropriate. If you often tell jokes, you look imprudent and untrustworthy. Those who are your senior will not be able to share secrets with you and hesitate to assign work of a serious nature to you. Ephesians 5:4 warns us God's beloved children saying, "and there must be no filthiness and silly talk, or coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks."

Vocabulary that is in vogue is a reflection of worldly trends. So, if you speak using the vocabulary, you become imbued with its worldly trends. Even though the worldly words don't have evil in the meaning, they are not fit for God's children who are longing to enter New Jerusalem. You have to remember that you should abstain from worldly discussions and conversations in the temple of God and its courtyards.

## Grace-giving Words!

Ephesians 4:29 reads, "Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear."

The words that give grace to those who hear and build up edification are appropriate for the children of God. They include the words that are worthy to glorify God, plant faith into others' hearts, and give life to listeners. That's why in whatever situation you have to make it a rule to examine whether or not your words are beneficial to others and yourself.

## Say No Word That Goes Over Your Limitation!

A humble person doesn't say the words that go too far above his position. He keeps his position and acts within the

limitation of that position. On the contrary, an arrogant person tends to speak out the words that go over the limitations of his position.

For example, words that pass judgment and condemnations on others and gossiping and slandering others fall into this category. It is the same as becoming a judge even though God Himself alone is the Judge (James 4:11-12). If anyone passes judgment and condemnations on a servant of God who is accompanied with proofs of God's presence and confirmation, it is as though he is going against God Himself. It is considered a grave sin.

Words of complaint, grumblings and groaning also fall into this category. The children of God have been saved from the path leading to fall into the unquenchable fire of Hell and are being led on the path to Heaven by the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ. That's why if they speak out words of grumbling or complain against others in difficult situations, it is deemed as the same as forgetting the grace of salvation. A wise person who knows his position can give thanks in any circumstances.

This applies to accomplishing works of God. A humble person who knows his place only gives thanks and obeys no matter what kind of duties he is assigned. He is grateful for the fact that he is allowed to do works of God. If you complain wondering why you should have to do that kind of duty, it means you have already gone well over your station. When she was informed by the angel of the Lord that she would be pregnant, the virgin Mary said, "Behold, the bondservant of the Lord; may it be done to me according to your word" (Luke 1:38).

## Only Positive Words and the Confession of Faith!

Proverbs 18:21 reads, "Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit." You have to avoid from saying negative words in your daily life but instead make it a rule to speak positive words and make a confession of faith. Negative words have negative influence on hearers because they make the mood gloomy and distract people's enthusiasm. Conversely, positive words bring a bright and lively atmosphere. They encourage people to do their work with confidence and take courage again.

When he fought against Goliath, young David didn't look at the reality with human eyes or speak any negative words. He looked up to the almighty God alone and walked up to the champion making only a confession of faith found in 1 Samuel 17:45-47. As a result, he defeated the champion completely by causing him to fall to the ground with a piece of smooth stone.

When the Israelites arrived at the entrance of the Canaan land, ten of the twelve spies who had been sent to scout the land prior to conquering it told the people negative things about the land and the people were discouraged (Numbers 13:31-33). Negative words discourage those who have little faith and let them fall into temptations. For this reason, whenever you feel like speaking out negative words, you have to bridle your tongue and do your best to make a profession of faith all the time. Then, your heart and the situations will change by your faith.
