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“The Latter Glory of This House Will Be Greater Than the Former”

In 2015 God will be glorified more greatly in the flow of whole spirit and through the power of re-creation



Manmin Central Church has proclaimed God the Creator, Jesus Christ, and the works of the Holy Spirit by working with its approximately 10,000 branch and associate churches in the world and through Dr. Lee's multi-lingual books, newspapers, GCN (Global Christian Network), WCDN (World Christian Doctors Network), and MIS (Manmin International Seminary). In 2015 Manmin will achieve the God-given visions greatly and the providence of the end time by revealing a greater glory than the former.

On December 28, 2014 in the 2015 Annual General Meeting, Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee spoke these words, “Dear pastors and all members of our nearly 10,000 branch and associate churches, we have many things to do in 2015 to accomplish God's providence for the end time. I pray in the name of the Lord that you will come forth as fruit of spirit and whole spirit quickly, accomplish the providence of the end time with your shepherd, and enter New Jerusalem full of God's glory.”

At his time he also announced four visions given by God for 2015 as follows:

The first one is 'Glory' (Haggai 2:9). Manmin Central Church has glorified God with countless signs, wonders, and powerful works manifested by Dr. Lee and has been spreading the holiness gospel to every corner of the world. However, since this end time is so completely full of sins, only when the latter glory is incomparably greater than the former,

will the eyes of all people of all nations be opened and the people will then be able to meet the living God. Now the shepherd has already fulfilled the requirement of justice with his sacrifices. So, in 2015, Manmin will give much greater glory to God through innumerable works.

The second is 'Fruit' (1 Thessalonians 5:23). In God's view, the perfect fruit of human cultivation are people of whole spirit. In 2014 Manmin accomplished the standardization of spirit thanks to the shepherd's sacrifice and in 2015 they will ride on the flow of whole spirit in earnest. Not only should Manmin ride well on this flow, but they must also go forth out to the world with the handkerchief of power (Acts 19:11-12) and guide countless souls to the Lord. By doing so, they will bear good and perfect fruit of whole spirit abundantly.

The third vision is 'Beautiful Sanctuary' (Revelation 21:10-11). God has been making a way for the

church to build here on this earth, the magnificent and beautiful sanctuary revealing the glory of New Jerusalem. Above all else, God earnestly hopes that in the sanctuary His sanctified children will glorify Him offering up praises and reverence for Him. These enormous projects of the construction of the Canaan and Grand sanctuaries are going to be embarked upon shortly when the comprehensive blessing comes in. Note that the more people of whole spirit that Manmin has, the more quickly they will be able to build the Grand Sanctuary.

The fourth and last vision is 'The Power of Re-creation' (Genesis 1:3). The power of re-creation refers to the power that restores or renews the things that God created. Currently, not only is the world full of sins and evil, but so are the people. However, the power of re-creation will change even the most maliciously-hearted people for whom it seems being saved is impossible. So, even those like Judas Iscariot will be made to kneel down

before the name of God. It is in this way that people of all nations will be led to the way of salvation, to answers, and to blessings. At the same time, more believers will be guided to New Jerusalem, which will perfectly glorify God.

The four visions show the big picture of 2015 and bring great expectations. In 2015, by the manifestation of the power of re-creation, the waves of spiritual renewal will travel unimpeded to Korean Christian churches and even to the whole world. In this flow Manmin should be ever more tightly united with the shepherd at the center, receive God-prepared comprehensive blessings, and give great glory to God.

Dr. Lee also wished the members peace and happiness, saying, “In 2015 I will let no one remain poor or sick in this church with which God is walking. If we obey the Word of God, we will never become sick. I will plant this faith in the hearts of newcomers and pray for them so that they can be healed of their diseases.”

“The latter glory of this house will be greater than the former,” says the LORD of hosts, “and in this place I will give peace,” declares the LORD of hosts” (Haggai 2:9).



A dictionary defines ‘glory’ as ‘very great praise, honor, or distinction.’ The only ones who can be recipients of this glory are God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit: the Triune God. However, John 13:32 states, “If God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and will glorify Him immediately.”

This does not just mean that God wants to be exclusively glorified, but implies that He also wants to give glory to those who glorify Him as well. Now I will tell you how we will glorify God and how He will give glory to us.

1. God will be glorified in the name of the shepherd

John 14:13 reads, “Whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son.” Here, in order that we may glorify God, sacrifice must have been made to pay for justice accordingly.

Jesus also made sacrifices that words cannot express to become the King of kings and the Lord of lords. Philippians 2:6-8 says, “[Christ Jesus] who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.” As written, though Jesus existed in the form of God and was united as one with God, He humbled and sacrificed

Himself to the point of death on the cross. Then He was exalted as the King of kings and Lord of lords, and thereby He glorified God (Philippians 2:9-11).

This principle of justice is applied the same today. For the last 32 years, since the founding of this church, and since 2010 in particular, the years have not been easy years, but they have been years of patient endurance and sacrifice of all I have. To support his wife and children and help them lead comfortable and happy lives, a husband and father needs to and ought to make a great deal of sacrifices. If I had given up on the souls who seemed unable to make it, or if I had left the souls behind so that they had to take care of themselves, my sacrifices wouldn’t have been as big as they were. However, I couldn’t let go of a single soul. Instead, I understood them, embraced them, and forgave them with love. As such, my pain and sacrifices became greater.

In return for the sacrifice, God says He will be glorified in 2015. He adds that the glory will be incomparably greater than the former glory (Haggai 2:9).

Through healing and answers; through signs, wonders, and countless works of God’s power, God has been glorified. But God says it is not even close to being enough. Since sin and evil are so prevalent in this world, He says that we need the works that can reveal His glory even more greatly and amazingly so that numerous souls of the world are able to witness them and seek God.

Just as Habakkuk 2:14 says, “For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea,” my goal is to let the glory of God fill the whole earth. For this to be, God has given me power upon power for the past years. He has also let many people of spirit and of whole spirit come forth on the security of my sacrifices.

Since Jesus fulfilled the law with His love and accomplished His mission as the Savior, countless souls have been able to walk the way of salvation. Thanks to the justice that the Lord piled up, those countless souls who were benefited from it could receive the blessing of salvation. And, the enemy devil and Satan cannot bring

about any accusations concerning it.

The enemy devil and Satan have clearly seen the kind of love I have also piled up within this justice. Therefore, when so many souls enter New Jerusalem as well as countless souls come within the boundary of salvation, the enemy devil and Satan cannot make any accusation concerning it either.

Romans 8:17 says, “And if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.” To receive the glory in the future, you must take up your own crosses. You must fill up your personal measures of justice of your own by all means available to you.

2. He will be glorified through you who come out as the fruit of the shepherd

In 2015, it is time that you should fill up each of your own measures of justice so that you can do many works. As you glorify God in doing so, He who is glorified through you will return glory to you.

John 15:8 says, “My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples.” The disciples of Jesus appeared so fragile that they didn’t seem to be able to do anything without Jesus beside them, but after the resurrection of Jesus, they became completely different.

The sacrifice of Jesus’ taking the cross opened the way of salvation for them, and gave the confidence of resurrection to them in their hearts. They received the Holy Spirit and were renewed amazingly. From that time on they sacrificed and gave up all they had for the Lord. And through such disciples, many fruits were borne, and God was glorified. Only then could they be confidently called the ‘disciples of the Lord’.

If they had not changed after the resurrection of the Lord and devoted themselves to the point of giving up even their lives, could they have been remembered as the disciples of the Lord today? From now you should also go out with confidence, gather countless fruits, and glorify God.

In order to do so, just as the Lord

said in Matthew 5:16, “Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven,” we must be the ones who can ‘shine your light’. We must cast off evil and sanctify ourselves so that the light given out from us might shine before people. As we shine the light like this, our good works will cause people to glorify God.

Moreover, as you become sanctified, God will give you spiritual authority and strength from above. Then, you will be able to defeat the forces of darkness and take up the duty of saving countless souls; this will glorify God. Moreover, as you come into whole spirit, you can do even greater and more amazing works. But first of all, to take the responsibility, you must be a worker of spirit.

The world will be darker and more hardened. To shine light and glorify God in such a world, we must be the light. Countless people of spirit must come out as the light. This light should shine in all parts of the world. People of spirit should let the powerful light shine out to defeat the forces of the antichrist. They should go out to the world, manifest the works of God’s power, and penetrate people’s souls, spirits, joints, and marrow with the words of spiritual authority. Only then can they lead numerous souls to the way of salvation in a short period of time and glorify God.

2 Thessalonians 1:12 says, “So that the name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.” As said, through you who shine the light out toward the world, God and the Lord receive glory, and you will be also given the glory. I hope that all of you will participate in this ministry of blessing and glory.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I urge you to diligently come out as precious men of spirit and of whole spirit so that you can glorify God as much as you want in 2015. I pray in the name of the Lord that God will be glorified through you and give you glorious crowns and you will enjoy the inexpressible glory in New Jerusalem forever and ever.

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Spiritual ‘Manna’ from Heaven Is Given to This Wilderness-like World



Spiritual manna from heaven restores souls and renews their lives with God’s deep love contained in it. This ‘manna’ is provided in this book *Six-day Manna*. It is designed and organized for the purpose of conducting the members’ Cell Service held every week. Since its publication for the last 25 years, the book has been delivering countless people out of the wilderness-like world and leading them to ‘Canaan’ the land flowing with milk and honey. Its newly revised edition has recently been published. Part I describes the love of God in His creating men in His image and cultivating them to gain true children. Parts II and III explain about Jesus Christ, who is the way to salvation, and the message of the cross. Part IV succinctly covers methods to gain and maintain true faith and achieve perfect salvation. Part V deals with the measures of faith and heavenly dwelling places and Part VI explains about Christian feasts.

‘Manna’ the bread given by God to the Israelites in the wilderness

God wanted to deliver the Israelites from their slavery in Egypt and lead them to Canaan, the land flowing with milk and honey. But in order to enter the land of blessing, they had to pass through the wilderness.

In the wilderness, yet though they had experienced God’s works many times during the exodus from Egypt, they still blamed God for their suffering of thirst and hunger. Moses prayed to God, and in the answer to his prayer, God changed bitter water at Marah into sweet water and He also sent them manna and quail so that they could satisfy their thirst and hunger.

The ‘manna’ is well-illustrated in Exodus 16:14—“When the layer of dew evaporated, behold, on the surface of the wilderness there was a fine flake-like thing, fine as the frost on the ground.” Exodus 16:31 says, “The house of Israel named it manna, and it was like coriander seed, white, and its taste was like wafers with honey.”

For the Israelites, the ‘manna’ was just bread to maintain their lives in the 40-year-journey in the wilderness (Exodus 16). However, for us who are living in the wilderness-like world, God is providing ‘spiritual manna’—the Word of God, and it is also Jesus Christ who is the Word who became flesh and came to the earth. God’s Word, spiritual manna, gives us eternal life.

‘Spiritual Manna’

John 6:48-51 reads, “I am the bread of life. Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. This is the bread which comes down out of heaven, so that one may eat of it and not die. I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever...”

God provided manna to the sons of Israel throughout their lives in the wilderness; but He let them gather it for six days and on the seventh day He gave them the sabbath. That is, He allowed them to rest on the seventh day just as God rested on the seventh day after His six-day creation of all things (Genesis 2:2-3).

Today, we keep the Lord’s Day on Sunday as the day of spiritual rest. On the Lord’s Day, we gather in church, worship God, and listen to the message. We have spiritual food from heaven, communicate with God, and have fellowship with other members.

During the remaining six days, we have to diligently read the Word of God, which is spiritual manna, and pray fervently. If you feel the love of God in giving you spiritual manna and live by His Word every day, you will amazingly and most assuredly reap fruit of blessing.

After meeting the living God and being called as His servant, Dr. Jaerock Lee wanted to know His heart and will more; so he offered up countless prayers and fasting.

God accepted his dedication and gave him detailed explanations of things of the spiritual world written in the Bible such as: the providence of God’s creation; the message of the cross; Heaven and Hell; the measure of faith; and spirit, soul, and body.

In His Great Love, He Gave Me a New Life on the Doorstep of Death

‘Am I really breathing? Am I really walking?’

Now I feel joy as if I flew in the sky, and I am thinking of what I underwent recently.

On the doorstep of death due to septicemia

On October 23, 2014 I had a mild fever that became high and caught chills, but I didn't take it seriously. On November 2 I had pain all over my body. I could neither move, sleep, sit up nor stand. Worse yet, I lost all my strength and then even consciousness.

In the early morning on November 4, 2014, I was rushed to the emergency room by ambulance. My medical test result was shocking. My blood sugar level was over 500 mg/dl, and my blood pressure dropped to 50. In fact I had had diabetes since three years ago, but it had caused no problem. At that time, however, I had a lowered immune function and even ate raw fish that a diabetic person shouldn't eat. It caused hypoalkalinity, a dehydration phenomenon, and kidney disease followed. I even had septicemia that put me in 90% death risk.

Thereupon I looked back on my past life, found my self-righteousness that remained in my heart, and repented of it before God. I had been guided to Manmin Central Church by my wife in January 1993. I was touched by Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee who is

sincere and truthful and I felt his love. Meantime I renewed my heart and worked earnestly for the kingdom of God. Yet I still insisted on my opinion, failing to rely completely on God.

I was born after my parents had already had four daughters, so they were very excited and happy. Naturally I got all of their love while growing up, which caused me to have strong self-centered way of thinking and strong self-esteem. But when I was sick like that there was nothing that I could do. I realized that nothing can be achieved with my own ability. Thereby I put it in my heart that I had been living by the grace of God, the Lord, and the shepherd.

I came to life by Senior Pastor's prayer

Even after being moved to hospital, I had a high fever and great pain. I couldn't control my body. I woke up every two minutes. On November 6, Rev. Heesun Lee, Guidance Pastor of Men's Mission prayed for me with the handkerchief which Senior Pastor had prayed on (Acts 19:11-12). After that I slept well. The next day, however, I suffered from a high fever, a chill, and pain again.

At 5 A.M. on November 8, I received Senior Pastor's prayer by phone through Rev. Lee. An hour later I had a prescheduled blood test and urine examination. The test showed

that serious septicemia, hypoalkalinity, and dehydration phenomenon were all gone and my blood pressure and body temperature became normal. Inflammation levels also dropped. Hallelujah! My doctor said it was a miracle and was totally astonished.

I wrote about this happy news to my Senior Pastor who was in the mountain prayer house. I expressed my heartfelt thanks to him because I had gained a new life through his prayer. Had it not been for the grace of God and the Lord and the shepherd's powerful prayer, I wouldn't be in this world now.

In addition capillaries over my body had burst and my skin became red except for parts seen by others but this symptom disappeared in a week and my skin turned soft. My physical constitution was improved in God's delicate love. Furthermore I had a great time to look back upon myself and to renew myself in God's great grace. I came to feel more thankful and valued people around me all the more.

I regained my life so now I am full of thanks and love to God

Since having gained a new life, I have felt so thankful and moved by the love of God in praise and prayer. The messages delivered in church have become more touching to me; I am just excited to worship God. I also realized the importance of my family members, and give thanks to God for loving all

my family members.

My children have grown up so well that they had no problem even though they were adolescents. They stayed healthy without going to hospital or taking medicine. My first daughter Sister Hyejin Kim is a member of Heavenly Dance Team of Performing Arts Committee and a group leader. My second daughter Sister Hyemin Kim is a group leader. My wife Senior Deaconess Sunhee Park is a leader of sub-district leaders in the second Great Grand Parish. I am vice president of Men's Mission. We work diligently for the kingdom of God and feel more happiness and joy cherishing one another all the more than ever before.

I have organized and prepared the events of Manmin Summer Retreat for several years. So I was able to witness the powerful works manifested by Dr. Lee in close proximity. I felt so grateful for doing such a rewarding job. Moreover in recognition of my work for the retreat, the church gave me Plaque of Appreciation in the 2015 Annual General Meeting. How can I thank God enough!

I extend my thanks and love to Senior Pastor who prayed for me with great love and power so that I could gain a new life on the threshold of death and has raised me with the truth. I give all thanks and glory to God who is alive working with me.



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
