After the COVID-19 pandemic, when I turned fifty, I developed rhinitis, and it gradually worsened. I had to live with a constantly runny nose and severe sneezing, and even wearing a mask did not keep it under control. Because I work in the food service industry, I was exposed to smoke and humidity, which made my symptoms even worse. I had to take rhinitis medication three times a day. I needed to take medicine every day of the week, and especially in the spring when pollen was heavy or in the dry autumn season, my symptoms became so severe that I had to receive not only medication but even antibiotic

injections.

In December 2023, Pastor Emeritus passed away, and when I visited his memorial site in the spring of 2024, my heart was changed. As I reflected on my complacent life of faith, I shed many tears in repentance and resolved that I should repay the grace I had received through him by living a more diligent Christian life.

After that, I did my best not to cease praying in my circumstances, and I faithfully attended Daniel Prayer Meeting. Even when circumstances were unfavorable, I made sure to participate in the prayer meeting at home through the GCN broadcast.

I also offered Sunday worship more sincerely in spirit and truth and tried to attend other gatherings whenever possible.

At every service, I earnestly received the prayer for the sick from pastor Soojin Lee. As I continued running forward to change myself and repay the grace I had received, around Chuseok (Korean Thanksgiving) in 2025, my symptoms gradually began to improve. Before I realized it, I no longer needed to take rhinitis medication, and my sneezing stopped, with my runny nose almost completely gone.

Now, about five months later, I am living my daily life in peace without taking any medication at all. Hallelujah! Even my boss, who had always watched me suffer from rhinitis, was amazed. I give all thanks and glory to our good Father God who healed the rhinitis that could not be cured by medicine or injections.

Healed from a knee fracture in six days

On Wednesday, October 8 last year, during the Chuseok holiday, I went hiking with my family for the first time in a while. About fifteen minutes after we began the hike, my left ankle caught on a sharply protruding rock, and I fell. I tried to get back up and continue climbing, but the intense, stabbing pain in my knee made it impossible to take even

a single step, so I had no choice but to come back down the mountain. The descent was far more painful than the climb. Supporting myself with both hands on the ground, I barely managed to make my way down the mountain on one leg and finally got into a taxi.

The moment I touched my knee in the taxi, I could clearly feel that a bone had been broken. Although I arrived in front of my house, I was unable to take even one step, so I went straight to a nearby private clinic. There, I was immediately told to go to the emergency room of a large hospital. After an MRI scan in the emergency room, the doctor said, "Your kneecap is fractured. Unlike other bones, the kneecap is separated into upper and lower parts, so surgery is absolutely necessary."

And, the doctor recommended that even with surgery, I would need to use crutches and undergo rehabilitation therapy and suggested scheduling the operation for Friday, October 10. However, if I were hospitalized and had the surgery, I would not be able to attend the church's 43rd Anniversary Service on October 12. Desiring to be healed by faith, I chose not to be hospitalized and returned home. Thereafter, at every Daniel prayer meeting, I deeply repented in prayer for the times I had failed to pursue peace at work and at home, and I received pastor Soojin Lee's prayer for the sick each day.

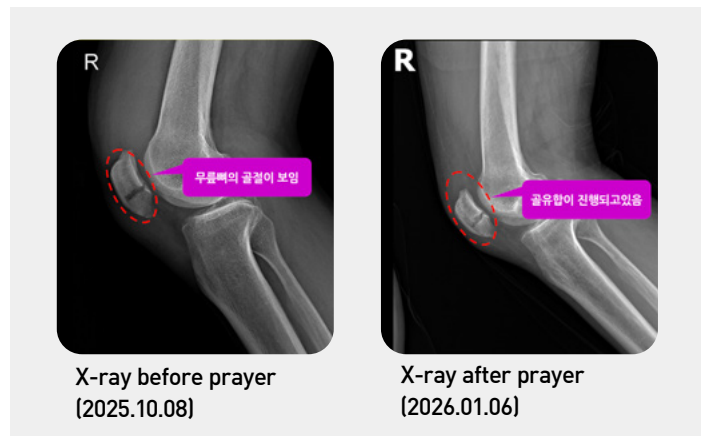
On October 12, the day of the church anniversary service, my knee pain was so severe that I struggled each time I put my foot down. I arrived early at the anniversary celebration with a wheelchair prepared. As

pastor Soojin Lee was entering the celebration hall, she saw me and greeted me with a nod. At that very moment, an indescribable peace filled my heart.

After the first service ended, faith was given to me, so I removed the splint and tried sitting without it. To my amazement, there was no discomfort in my leg at all. Then, during the second part of the service—the celebration—I felt prompted to remove the compression bandage as well, so I took it off and tried walking. Astonishingly, at that very moment, my leg didn't hurt.

After all the celebration had ended, as pastor Soojin Lee was heading back, my daughter said to her, "Please pray for my father." She immediately came over, laid her hand on my knee, and prayed for me. Right after that, I could feel the pain in my knee completely disappear. Next morning, something amazing happened. As usual, I was able to transfer between the bus and subway and go to work normally.

On October 14, six days after the fracture, I visited the hospital and took an X-ray. The doctor said, "The bone has almost completely healed. You just need to take good care of it now." The kneecap, which is more difficult to treat than other bones, had joined together in just a few days. Hallelujah! I give all thanks and glory to God who healed me.

The skin itching that had lasted for 10 years disappeared

For as long as ten years, I had a pain that followed me through life without a single day of rest, leaving deep marks on me. From the moment I opened my eyes in the morning until I went to bed at night—and even while I was asleep—it would not let me go. The name of that suffering was chronic skin itching.

Years ago, when I was a construction worker, I began dyeing my hair with the simple wish of looking just a little younger. I never imagined that this decision would lead to such a long and deep tunnel of suffering. At first, I thought the itching was just a passing discomfort, but before I knew it, it had become part of my daily life. Breaking down the boundary between day and night, it finally settled in as a pain that gripped my entire life.

Even at night, after finishing an exhausting day and finally lying down to rest, the suffering would not let me go. The more I clenched my teeth and tried not to scratch, the more persistently the itching burrowed into me. I even thought, ‘It would be better to have visible

wounds so that I might at least be able to explain this pain.’ Outwardly, I appeared fine, but this invisible suffering was quietly yet deeply consuming me, slowly wearing down my heart and mind.

I went from one hospital to another, changing medications and trying almost every treatment said to be effective, but the answers were always the same: “We don’t know the cause.” “Stop dyeing your hair.” I would smile on the outside and joke, “So you’re saying I have to live with gray hair all my life.” But inside, my heart was already completely worn out.

“Will this suffering ever end?” “Will I have to live like this for the rest of my life?” These questions never left my mind for even a single day, but followed me constantly like a shadow over my life. Then, on December 14, 2025, I registered at Manmin Central Church through the evangelism of deacon Kijoo Song. As I began attending church, the words of life delivered by pastor Soojin Lee became a decisive turning point that fundamentally changed the direction of my life, which had been bound in suffering for many years.

The focus of my life, which had been fixed only on problems and suffering, gradually shifted to a life that looks to the great and almighty God. From that moment on, in a

corner of my heart, a light of hope—one I had never experienced before and could not fully explain—began to spring up.

Then, on December 22 of the same year, one of the members handed me the Muan Sweet Water, which had turned from bitter water (Exodus 15:25). I used it on my body in faith, desiring to be healed. This was my act of faith—no longer relying on human methods, but entrusting entirely to God the problem I had once felt forced to give up on.

After that, something unforgettable and amazing happened in my life. When I lay down to sleep, I no longer needed to scratch, and when I opened my eyes in the morning, the suffering that had tormented me for so many years had disappeared without a trace. The itching, whose cause had been unknown for ten years, had completely stopped. Hallelujah!

This was not merely a slight improvement. It was complete healing. In that moment, I clearly realized that a problem which could never be solved by human hands could be resolved in an instant by God’s touch. I give all thanks, praise, and glory to Father God who immediately ended the deep, long suffering that had gripped me for ten years. I am also deeply grateful to deacon Kijoo Song who led me to the church.

The Last Seven Words on the Cross 7

“Father, INTO YOUR HANDS I COMMIT MY SPIRIT”

Jesus had suffered on the cross for a long time, shedding His blood and water. So, He had already been completely exhausted just before His death. Nevertheless, He cried out with a loud voice, "Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit," and then breathed His last. Unlike the fourth word where He cried, "My God, My God," here He addressed God as "Father," because His mission as the atoning sacrifice had been accomplished.

Jesus Committing His Spirit to God the Father

Then, what is the reason that Jesus who came to this earth as the Savior committed His spirit to God the Father? Since human beings consist of spirit, soul, and body (1 Thess 5:23), the spirit and soul leave the body upon death. At this moment, God's children go into the bosom of God the Father, but those who are not, go to hell (Luke 16:19–31). And the body is buried and decays, eventually returning to a handful of dust.

As the Son of God, Jesus also came to this earth in the flesh, and just like us, He had a spirit, soul, and body. However, because Jesus fulfilled all of God's will by being crucified, even though His body might die, no one could kill His spirit. Therefore, before He breathed His last, He committed His spirit

into the hands of God the Father.

If God received only our spirits and not our souls, what would happen? In heaven, we would only know the truth, but we would not understand the tears, sorrow, and pain we experienced on this earth—things known through the operation of the soul. Like Adam in the Garden of Eden, we would not be able to appreciate the happiness of heaven or give thanks from the heart. For this reason, God receives both our spirit and our soul together.

Another reason Jesus committed His spirit to God the Father is that the Creator God is the One who governs not only the providence and cycles of the universe but also the life, death, blessing, and curse of all human beings. Matthew 10:29–31

reads, "Are not two sparrows sold for a cent? And yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father... Therefore do not fear; you are more valuable than many sparrows." If even a single sparrow does not fall without God's permission, how much more so for the children of God?

Everything belongs to God and takes place under His sovereignty, and He alone is the One who answers our prayers. Therefore, Jesus Himself offered a prayer committing His spirit to God the Father.

The Reason Jesus Prayed with a Loud Voice

Then, why did Jesus deliberately pray with a loud voice, "Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit," even amidst the agony of the cross? It was to ensure that all the people could hear and understand, and also because it is the will of God to cry out in prayer with a loud voice. Furthermore, because it was a prayer committing His spirit to God, He cried out earnestly.

In addition, Jesus' prayer, "into Your hands I commit My spirit," is a declaration that He had fulfilled His mission by fully obeying every word in accordance with the will of God.
